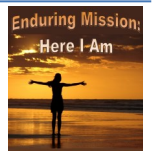

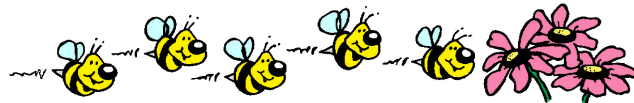

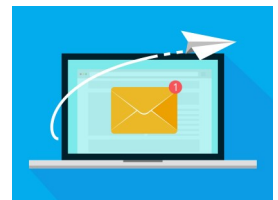
Blessing Books *Now through May 9th*

Due to COVID-19 restrictions the Rupp Arena at Central Bank Center, where the Lutheran Women's Missionary League (LWML) Convention will be held June 24–27, 2021, can only allow a limited number of people to attend. The arena can hold many but LWML must adhere to their restricted meal seating capacity which, at this time, is at 2,000 seats. Because of these restrictions, **LWML has shut down registrations at this time**. The LWML Board of Directors prayerfully anticipates that the percentage allowed will increase before June.
