Due to COVID-19 restrictions the Rupp Arena at Central Bank Center, where the Lutheran Women's Missionary League (LWML) Convention will be held June 24–27, 2021, can only allow a limited number of people to attend. Because of these restrictions, **LWML has shut down registrations at this time**. The LWML Board of Directors prayerfully anticipates that the percentage allowed will increase before June. 
