

WHO SHOULD "SIGN" THE BLESSING BOOKS? Everyone in the congregation can sign.


WHAT SHOULD I WRITE? Write a short note of Christian encouragement, share your favorite Bible verse or simply sign your name.


What: Walk to HyVee area sidewalk and beyond, returning to church. Route available at start line. You may walk as little or as far as you wish.


