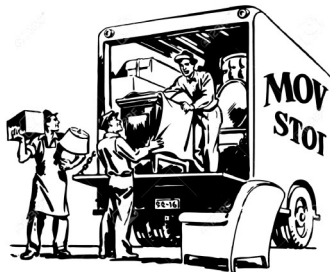
A CHANGE IN COMMUNION SCHEDULE FOR THE MONTH OF JULY

Won't tell you anything about what he did at school.

Some kids just like to keep home and school separate. Others find it confusing to try to summarize a day's events. Try asking about specifics. If you are really curious, feel free to check with your child's teacher.

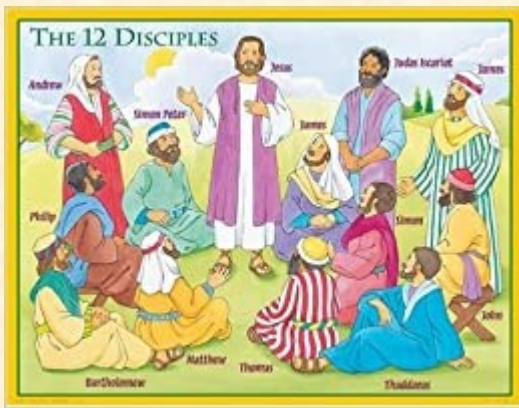
