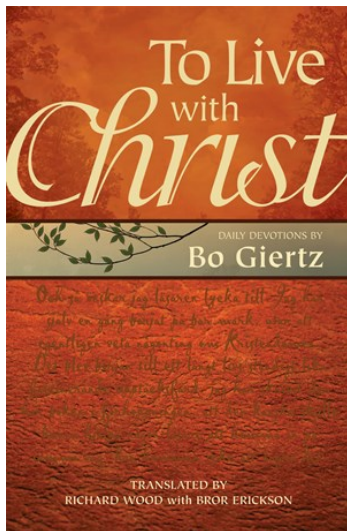


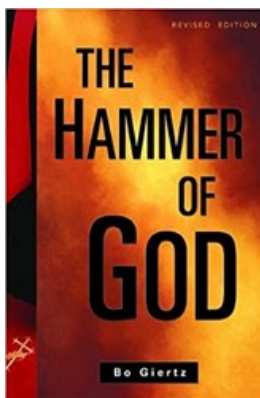

Name Tags Storage reinvented!!

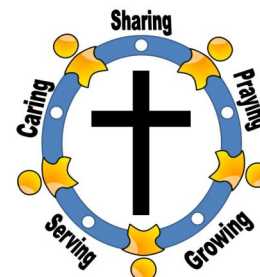
