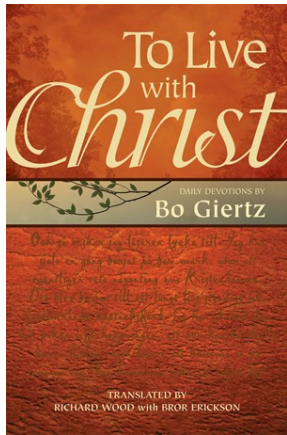

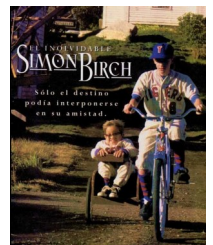
HELP WANTED!! Need vehicles and drivers

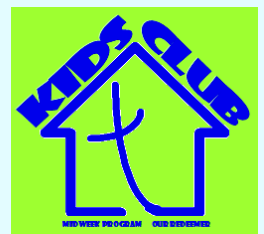
