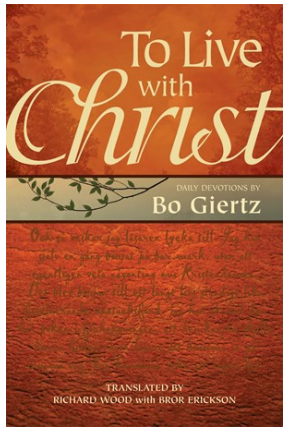

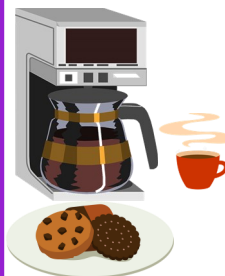

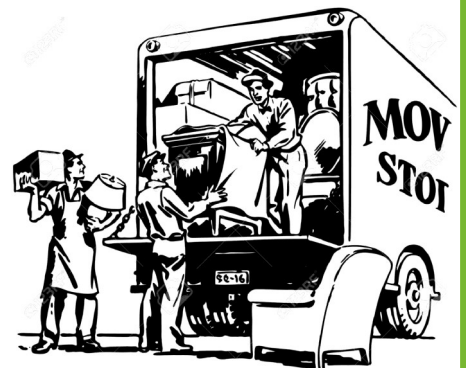
We appreciate keeping down the cost of making the pies. With your help there will be some FABULOUS pies in November for you to buy.
