


PRAYERFULLY SEEKING VOLUNTEERS TO HELP WITH THIS YEAR'S FUN FAITH FEST: AUGUST 14

STOCK THE PANTRY




The Garretts will be moving into the vicarage on August 5th. Let's give them a warm Our Redeemer welcome with things for their pantry.


