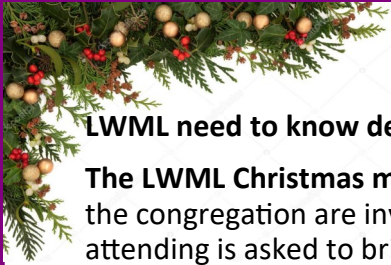

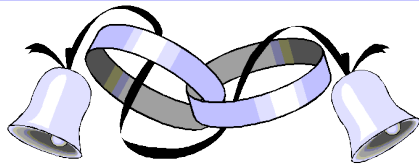


LWML need to know details:

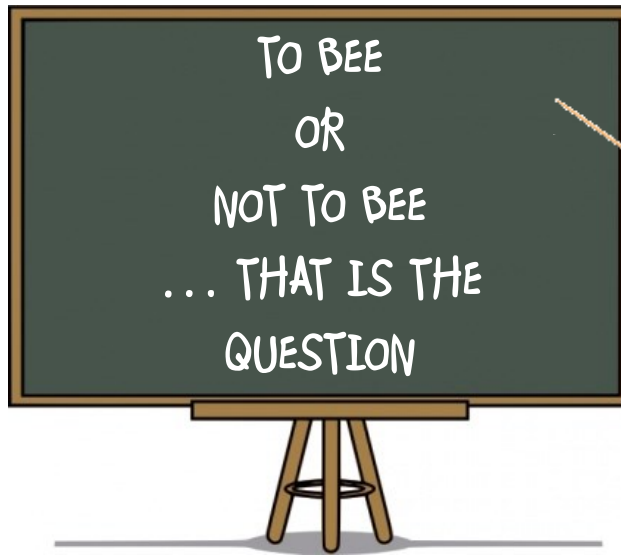
On January 3rd the Human Care Committee will gather the items for delivery to the Iowa City School District Administration Office for distribution to children in need when classes resume.

SUNDAY COFFEE SIGN-UP FOR 2023

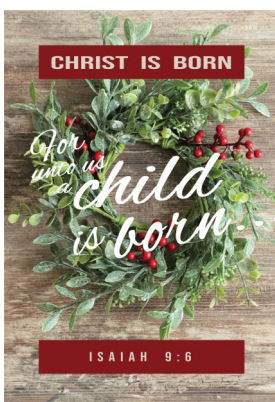
