





APPEARING AT OUR REDEEMER February 29, 2024 at 7:00 pm in the Sanctuary

Concordia University's A Cappella Choir has been performing concerts and joining congregations in worship for over 86 years. One of the United States' oldest touring Lutheran collegiate choirs, the University A Cappella Choir has performed throughout the U.S., and internationally in Greece, Italy, France, Egypt, Israel, Lebanon, India, Thailand, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Japan, the Philippines, Germany, Czech Republic, Slovakia, Latvia, Austria, Spain, Mexico, South Africa, and Australia.

The 72-voice choir is chosen by audition and is comprised of majors from most academic disciplines, representing many states and some foreign countries. Over 180 students audition each fall for the internationally renowned concert choir.

The choir has been invited to perform for NMEA and ACDA conferences, and international competitions. They received the Gold Medal for performance at the 12th Australian International Music Festival in Sydney and earned a spot in the winner's circle at the 42nd International Choral Competition in Spittal, Austria.

School Description

The preschool serves students ages 3-5 in three classes, including one class that is part of the "Four Year Old Voluntary Preschool" in collaboration with the Eldora New Providence Community School District. The goal of our preschool is to help the children in our care to develop and mature physically, emotionally, intellectually, socially and spiritually. We hope that each child will know that Jesus is their Good Shepherd, Savior and Friend. Our desire is that each boy and girl in our Preschool will reach their full potential and someday grow to become a happy, productive, creative, Christian adult. Good Shepherd Preschool has been part of our congregation and community for 47 years.

Job Qualifications

- An Early Childhood Education degree
- A member in good standing of a congregation of the Lutheran Church–Missouri Synod and/or willingness to join St. Paul Lutheran Church (an LCMS congregation)

Job Responsibilities

There are many responsibilities as the main teacher, here are some of those responsibilities:

- Provide planning and execution of the appropriate early childhood education experiences with a variety of materials in the fields of art, music, literature, science, math, physical development, language development, social studies, and health.
- To promote and supervise activities which promote the healthy, spiritual, emotional, social, intellectual and physical development of each child.
- To maintain records of progress, supervise all activities, complete forms required by the Department of Health and Human Services, and help maintain the classroom spaces and materials.
- To attend in-service training or conferences whenever possible- at least ten hours a year.
- Work with the pastor to help with the students spiritual growth.

The teacher we hire will also train to become the preschool director. Some of those duties include:

- Evaluate and report conformity for state and federal regulations.
- Keep records of attendance and tuition, recruit and supervise staff, prepare and spend within the budget and prepare monthly financial reports, promote and advertise the program and contact agencies to help students with special needs.
- Work with the pastor, Board of Education, and other boards of St. Paul Lutheran Church to prepare chapel, mission projects, and provide information about the program.
