



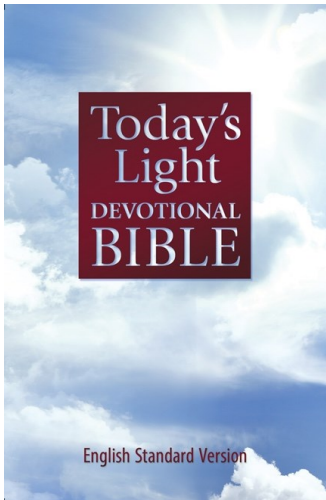

Also included in the lost and found and has been put in time out on Lorrie's desk is Piggy who would like to go home with his owner.



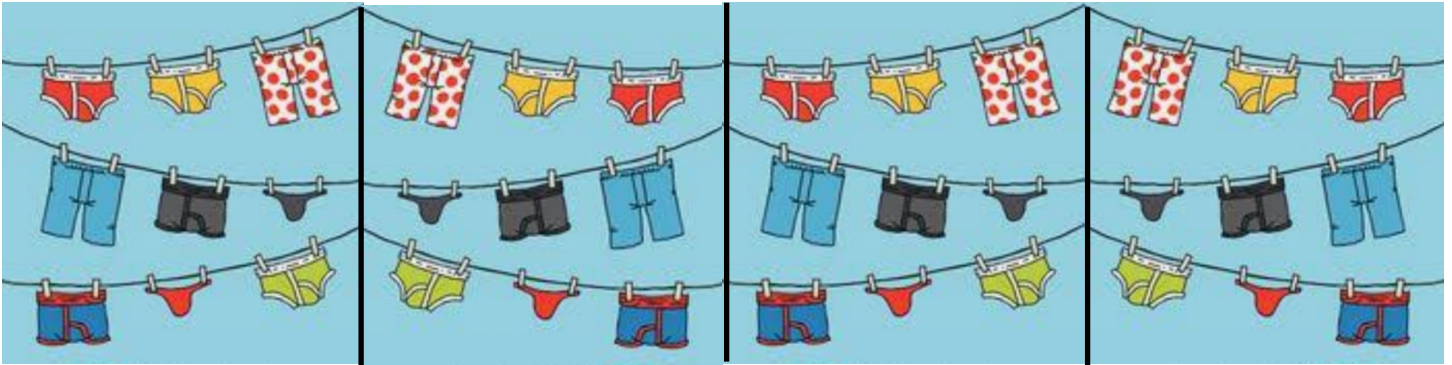

# UNDIES SUNDAY



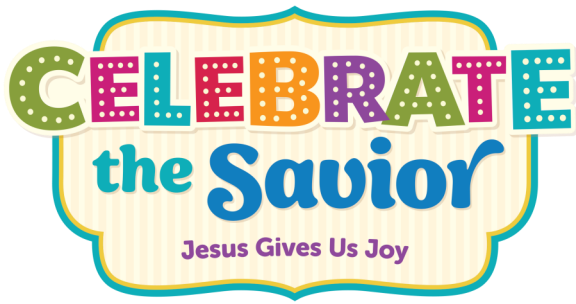
During the month of June, Our Redeemer Human Care Committee will be sponsoring our third annual "Undies Sunday" to benefit the Iowa City Shelter House.

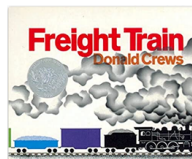
