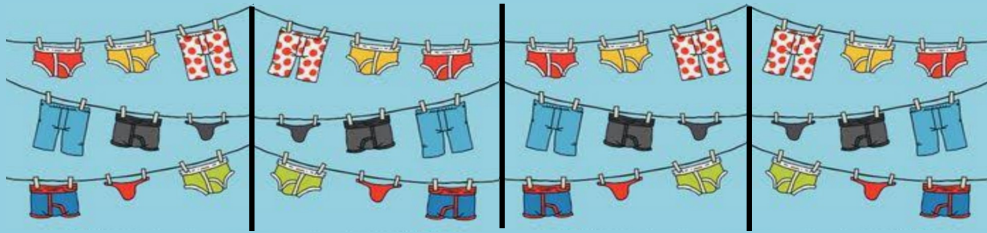
VOLUNTEERS & MOVERS NEEDED!!



Brings home a paper covered with 20 lbs. of glue and one tiny scrap of blue construction paper. Most kids concentrate on mastering one skill at a time when doing art projects. Our Redeemer Lutheran Church has a strong, caring ministry with children and youth. To promote the safest and most secure environment possible all employees and volunteers, both new and existing, undergo a background screening before working with younger members.
